- a complete record of all occupations, employers, locations and salaries (where disclosed by the graduate) returned in the DLHE survey of the cohorts completing this course in 2004 and 2005
- a figure for the percentage of all students enrolled at any time in those cohorts who successfully completed this course without repeating a year
- a description of how this course is improving graduates' employability, including the arrangements for teaching and assessing career management and for supporting students' professional development.
